1. Smile

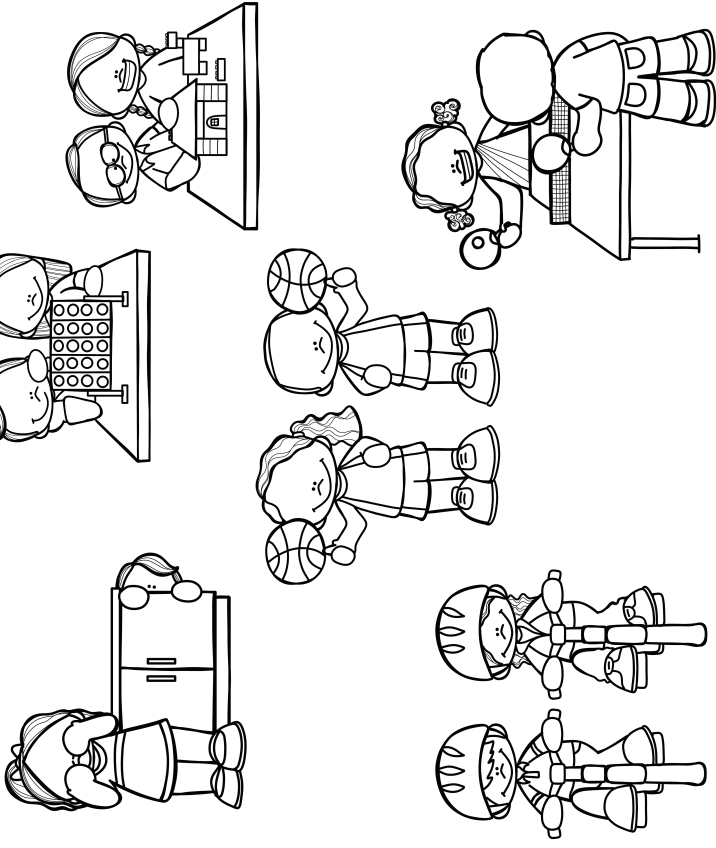
2. Eye contact

Here is how I can play fair:


