






SKILLS and STANDARDS

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<p>Back to School</p> 	<p>LANGUAGE ARTS</p> <p>First, middle and last sounds in CVC words, sight words, tracing and writing complete sentences, and spelling color words.</p> <p>MATH</p> <p>Which group has more or less, making teen numbers using a group of ten plus extra ones, sums of 5 and writing teen numbers in order.</p>
<p>September</p> 	<p>LANGUAGE ARTS</p> <p>First, middle and last sounds in CVC words, reading and matching CVC words, sight words, reading, comprehension, tracing and writing complete sentences.</p> <p>MATH</p> <p>Making teen numbers using a group of ten plus extra ones, 10 more 10 less using a number line, skip counting by ten, weight on a scale, subtraction using ten frames and coins.</p>
<p>October</p> 	<p>LANGUAGE ARTS</p> <p>CVC words, word families, consonant blends, sight words, reading, comprehension, writing complete sentences, and using picture word banks.</p> <p>MATH</p> <p>Addition using a number line, doubles addition facts, addition problems using pictures, tally marks, 3D solids, number bonds, counting and graphing, and counting by fives.</p>
<p>November</p> 	<p>LANGUAGE ARTS</p> <p>CVC words, word families, reading short stories, comprehension, long vowels with silent e, sight words, sentence starters, writing complete sentences, and using picture word banks.</p> <p>MATH</p> <p>Counting through 40, writing numbers 11-30, subtraction using ten frames and number lines, addition, more or less through 30, measuring to the closest inch, coloring $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ fractions, and determining if equations are true.</p>
<p>December</p> 	<p>LANGUAGE ARTS</p> <p>Beginning blends, sight words, reading comprehension (fill in the word that makes sense), correcting a sentence, word families, long vowels, and inflectional endings.</p> <p>MATH</p> <p>Addition doubles facts, missing addend of ten, counting and 1:1 correspondence, telling time to the hour, more or less, and one more one less using a number line.</p>

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January



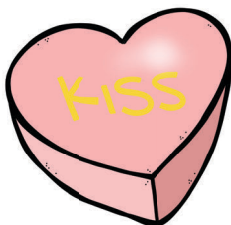
LANGUAGE ARTS

Inflectional endings, contractions, er/ir/ur spelling patterns, digraphs, compound words, word families, long vowels, sight words, reading comprehension (fill in the word that makes sense), and correcting a sentence.

MATH

Addition doubles facts plus one more, subtraction through 20 using a number line, more or less, measurement, even or odd numbers, ten more/ten less, and place value with tens sticks and extra ones.

February



LANGUAGE ARTS

Punctuation, possessive nouns, common nouns and proper nouns, adjectives, verb tense, beginning blends, sight words, double consonants, and r controlled vowels (er/ir/ur).

MATH

1 more 1 less, 10 more 10 less, addition with three numerals, subtraction using a number line, true/false equations, ordering numbers on a number line and using a hundreds chart.

March



LANGUAGE ARTS

Possessive nouns, digraphs, long vowels, vowel teams, writing complete sentences, combining two sentences using a conjunction, using pronouns, and inflectional endings.

MATH

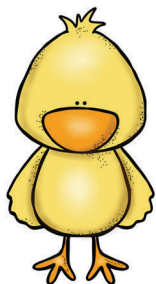
Solving for the missing subtrahend and addend, adding and subtracting ten within 120, filling in missing numbers on a number lines, skip counting, using a hundreds chart to solve problems, fact families, coins, and making equations equal.

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April



LANGUAGE ARTS

Long vowels with silent e spelling pattern, beginning blends, double consonants, digraphs, reading short stories with comprehension questions, and writing a complete sentence using words from the picture word bank.

MATH

Adding and subtracting within 120, skip counting, using a hundreds chart, telling time to the hour and half hour, place value, expanded notation, simple fractions ($1/2$ and $1/4$) and adding coins.

May



LANGUAGE ARTS

Punctuation, vowel teams, common nouns and proper nouns, adjectives, final blends, sight words, double consonants, reading short stories, writing complete sentences.

MATH

Addition and subtraction, using a hundreds chart, expanded notation, number bonds, balancing equations, tally marks, collecting data, telling time to the half hour, 2D shapes and 3D solids (sides, corners, vertices, shape name.)
