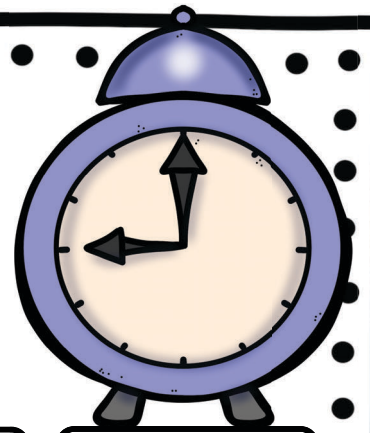

Cut out and put your routine in order! You can make one for each day of the week to hang up, or you can change it each day.

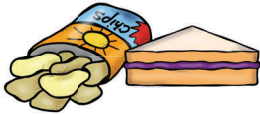

I hope this is a blessing for you and your children.



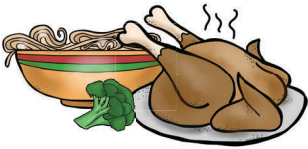

Right now, you may be wondering...

Is my child ready to go to school? Will they be scared? Will my child have friends in their class? What does my child need to know when school starts?

On the next page you'll find a chart with both academic and behavior goals. These skills will help your child be ready for school when kindergarten starts.

Please do not worry. They do not have to meet every single goal. This is just a great check-in to refer to when you're working with your child at home.

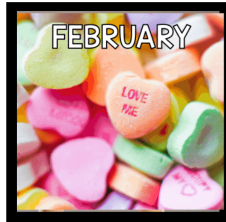
